- Small
 - Annual production less than 6 million barrels
- Independent
 - Less than 25% owned by a big brewery
- Traditional
 - Standard ingredients and methods


- \$33.9 billion economic impact

DANGER KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

FIRST AID

If in Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for

treatment advice. If Swallowed: Call a Poison Control Center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the Poison Control Center or doctor. Do not give anything by mourth to an unconscious person.

If on Skin or Clothing: Take off contiminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.

Have the product container or label with you when calling to Poison Control Center or a doctor or going for treatment. You may also contact 1-800-535-5053 for emergency treatment information.

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



